



Children's Cardiac Nursing 1: Foundation 2025 Courses



Overview:

Aimed at nurses who are new to working within cardiac services, and more experienced nurses working within other areas that provide care for cardiac patients but not as a speciality. This course focusses on cardiac anatomy and physiology of both the normal heart and the more common congenital cardiac lesions.

Assessment:

In-class multiple choice questionnaire (MCQ) and small group-work to produce a poster/teaching board on a topic of the candidates' choice, related to the nursing care of a child with a cardiac problem. Optional assessment - course designed so that students can obtain credits through their chosen university via an APEL route (Additional cost to student).

Requirements:

Commitment to attend all study days and complete self-directed study. 80% attendance is required for module completion. Attendance of Day 1 is mandatory.
